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### 1 Key Points

- Clontarf East A, Dublin City covers a total **area** of **2.1 square kilometers** and has a **population density of 1708.5** persons per square kilometer. The population density of Ireland as a whole is 73.3.
- The Age Dependency Ratio of this Electoral Division (ED) is 61. This compares to 53.2 nationally. The Age Dependency Ratio is the amount of people outside of working age (0-14 and 65+) per 100 people of working age (15-64).
- Clontarf East A, Dublin City has a total of **3626 persons** and **898 families** living in private households.
- There are a total of 681 persons aged 0-14 in this ED and 693 persons aged over 65.
- There are a total of **898** persons **living with a disability** in this ED, representing **24.8 percent** of the population. This compares with 21.5 percent nationally
- **79** people in this ED have **bad or very bad general health**. This represents **2.1 percent** of the population. 1.7 percent of the population have bad or very bad general health nationally.
- There are a total of **269 carers** in this ED, representing **7.4 percent** of the population. This compares with 5.8 percent of the population that are carers nationally.
- 11.5 percent of this ED smoke tobacco products. 13.1 percent of people nationally smoke tobacco products
- There are **32 short term unemployed** and **39 long term unemployed** people in this ED. These represent 1.1 and 1.3 percent of the population respectively.
- 1.3 percent of the population of Clontarf East A, Dublin City are unskilled. 3.1 percent of people in the state are unskilled.
- 21.6 percent of those aged 15+ in this ED have a highest level of education of lower secondary or lower. This compares with 23 percent nationally.
- 16.8 percent of families with children in this ED have lone parents. This stands at 24.8 nationally.
- 12.8 percent of this ED were born outside Ireland (20 percent nationally).
- Households rented from a Local Authority comprise 8.7 percent of households in this ED. This stands at 8.3 percent nationally
