

The study intents to determine the common factors leading to depression among grade 12 senior high school students of Asian Learning Center. The grade 12 senior high school students year 2018-2019 were selected to be the respondents with 261 randomly chosen senior high school students. The study was conducted in Asian Learning Center, Pajo Lapu-Lapu City. The research used the questionnaires adopted from Aaron Beck's Depression Inventory to identify the levels of depression. The percentage was used to compute and analyze the answers of the respondents with the help of the interpretation of a psychologist. The result of the study showed that the factors leading to depression were the negative view of the self and somatic/physical function factors wherein in the morning session punishment feelings and tiredness and fatigue were found to be the top and the least cause of depression. In the afternoon session, past failures and change of sleeping pattern were the top and the least cause of depression while self-criticalness and change of sleeping pattern were found to be the cause of depression among the night session.
