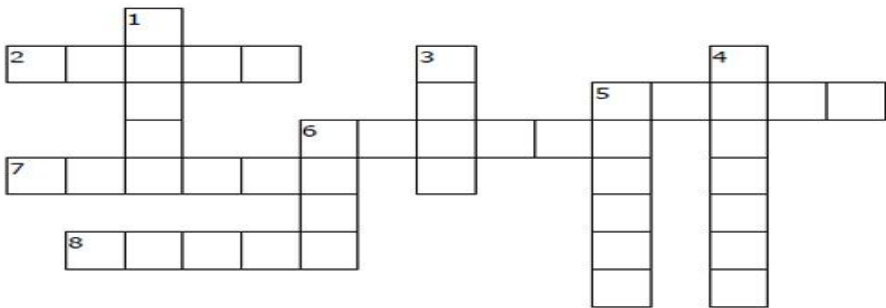

The spirit of Goliath represents **big enemies and giant problems**. If you are currently battling with a situation or an entity that is threatening your peace, harassing you and intimidating you, you are facing a Goliath. If there is a situation or entity that is seeking to enslave you, you are facing a Goliath.

YOUR GOLIATH CAN BE.....

"Envy, greed, fear, laziness, doubt, vice, pride, lust, selfishness, discouragement - all spell Goliath."

- In your life, there may appear to be people who are attacking you, your character, your work, your calling or something else. Understand that it is more than likely a spiritual attack to produce fear, anger or doubt in you.
- There are 3 types of Goliaths in our life that attacks us holistically.

3 Types of Goliath in our life

1. The Emotional Goliath

- A kind of Goliath that attacks you emotionally, always look for a soft spot in your life and attack you straight to it. Remind you of how weak you are and how sinful you are.
- David's Emotional Goliath: 1 Samuel 17:28 (His brothers judgement towards him)
- David did not give in.

2. Authoritative Goliath

- A kind of Goliath that uses guilt and false judgement towards you. Repeating your past life, your sins and whispering that you are not changed.
- David's Authoritative Goliath: 1 Samuel 17:33 (Attacks his weakness)
- David did not give in

3. The Able Goliath

- A kind of Goliath within yourself that doubts your ability to do things, sometimes people who think that you can never be a better person or you can never be a successful person.
- David's Able Goliath
- 1 Samuel 17:43-44 (People's Negative thoughts towards you)
- David did not give in

What are the 5 stones for defeating giants in your life?

STONE #1: COMMITMENT.

STONE #2: COURAGE.

STONE #3: COMMUNICATION.

STONE #4: CAPABILITY.

STONE #5: CONFIDENCE.

WORDS TO PONDER

1. When David agreed to fight Goliath, he wasn't motivated by reward. He didn't set out to make a name for himself and earn respect. But unlike every other Israelite man at the battlefield—including his own brothers—he was unafraid. What was the source of courage for this adolescent boy, unarmed and inexperienced? Belief in who God said He was.
2. David's courage came from the God who guarantees victory. David had known the protection of Yahweh. While tending his sheep, he had faced lions and bears, and the Lord has rescued him. He believed (rightly) that God would rescue him again from the hands of Goliath. Goliath was big, but God was infinitely bigger.
3. With one shot, David sank a stone into the forehead of Goliath, and victory was the Lord's.
4. When the Philistines saw their champion defeated, they fled for their lives. Before this fight, most people would've said David didn't stand a chance. But David showed that "with God nothing shall be impossible" (Luke 1:37). With God's help, you can stand your ground with faith and be triumphant.
