Prepared for the DAO archive channel. Every result below is sourced to its Snapshot record.

July 2026 closed six Snapshot votes: five proposals and one election. Three proposals passed with near-unanimous support: a temporary suspension of new treasury-funded activity, continued funding for the Discord Bot, and the Amendment to Leadership Structure. One proposal passed narrowly, with real opposition: removing the voting whitelist and geographic restrictions for general DAO members, at 53.76 percent for, 37.78 percent against. One proposal failed decisively: continuing the FINPR marketing campaign, rejected 71.36 percent against with zero votes for. The High Council election, corrected midmonth after a voting method error, elected three seats: Buffy, NekoyaManeki, and Light.

Temporary Suspension of New Treasury-Funded Activities

New treasury-funded proposals, grants, and bounties are paused until the High Council publishes a readiness assessment, reviewed every six months. Work already approved before the suspension continues to completion.

Continuation of Marketing and PR with FINPR

A three-month, 12,650 USDT extension of the DAO's FINPR marketing and PR campaign did not pass.

Increase Governance Accessibility and Protect Contributor Privacy

Removes the voting whitelist requirement and geographic restrictions for General DAO Members. Geographic limits stay in place for High Council Members and General DAO Leadership.

High Council Elections

27 votes · Closed 24 Jul

This election filled three High Council seats. The original vote used ranked-choice voting, built for a single winner, which produced unreliable rankings for a three-seat race. The DAO reset the vote and reran it under Approval voting: every voter ticks every candidate they support, and the top three by vote count win.

Buffy 32.94% · NekoyaManeki 26.6% · Light 19.75% · Raj 13.23% · 0xGodwin 7.1% · Sirusoof 0.38%

Elected: Buffy, NekoyaManeki, and Light. This continues the six-month High Council cycle that began with the prior council, elected in January 2026.

2. Structural and Rulebook Changes

The Amendment to Leadership Structure replaces the Constitution's generic Leadership positions with five defined, appointed roles: Treasurer, Governance and Proposals Officer, Technical and Ecosystem Liaison, Community and Communications

Officer, and Strategy and Performance Officer. The High Council stays elected and keeps governance authority. The five Operational Leadership roles are appointed by the High Council through a published, merit-based process, each for a six-month term with one extension. A member inactive for 30 continuous days without notice can be declared vacant by High Council majority. Removal is now possible for serious misconduct, not only poor performance. If no qualified community candidate is available, the High Council can ask the Redbelly Foundation to temporarily fill a role for up to 12 months, except the Treasurer position, which the Foundation cannot fill due to conflict of interest.

Constitution v1.2 has not been updated since September 2025. This amendment and the Governance Accessibility proposal above are the current source of truth on leadership structure and voting eligibility, not the published Constitution text.
