

RULES AND REGULATION

MANAGEMENT

- 1.1. The PIPOC 2023 Golf Tournament (The Championship) shall be managed by an Organising Committee (the Committee) appointed by Conference Management Secretariat.

ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1. The Championship is open to all PIPOC 2023 Congress participants/ exhibitors/invited guests who: (a) are amateurs in accordance with the Rules of Amateurs Status of the Royal & Ancient (R&A) Golf Club of Saint Andrews and the U.S.G.A; (b) have a U.S.G.A. handicap or such other handicap as may be accepted by the Committee of not more than 24 for man and 36 for woman as at 17 November 2023; (c) in the case of residents of Malaysia, are members of Clubs affiliated to the Malaysian Golf Association (MGA) or Malaysian Ladies Golf Association (MALGA).
- 2.2. Participation is on a first-come, first served basis. The Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any entry without giving any reason for such acceptance or rejection.

VENUE & DATES

- 3.1. The Championship shall be played at the Staffield Country Resort, Mantin, Negeri Sembilan on Sunday, 5 November 2023 or at any other venue and date as the Committee may decide.

RULES OF PLAY

- 4.1. All play shall be in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews and the Local Rules of Staffield Country Resort.

TIME OF STARTING

- 5.1. Tee-off time is schedule at 1330 hours, shot-gun start for all fixtures, or such other time and mode of starting as the Committee may decide. Players must report to the Starter at least ten (10) minutes before their starting time. Those who fail to report by the slotted time will be referred to the Committee which decision on whether to allow the participant to play or not, shall be final.
- 5.2. The players time for starting shall be that shown on the official Order of Play Sheet for their group or when their group is called by the Starter, whichever is the later.

FORMAT OF PLAY

- 6.1. The Championship will be played over 18 holes as a Stableford competition.
- 6.2. Results will be grouped in three divisions: 'A' Division; 'B' Division and 'C' Division.
- 6.3. The format of play is The Stableford System 36. However, for the category of Best Gross, it will be determined by Stroke Play.
- 6.4. During the game, should a player find it is no longer possible to score any more points for a hole, or do not finish any hole, the player should hole-out and proceed to the next tee-box. He/she will be given a score of Double Par for the hole.
- 6.5. Points allocated for scoring under System 36 are 1 point for a bogey and two points for a par, birdie and eagle. The indexes for the hole will not be used to determine the handicap. After all the players have finished, the players' score for 18 holes will be totalled, and then use half of the par of the course to subtract their score.
- 6.6. Slow play will not be tolerated. One reminder will be given and a second reminder will incur a two stroke penalty. For subsequent offence, the player will be disqualified.
- 6.7. The Committee reserves the right to cancel any round at its discretion in the event that playing 18 holes is *made impracticable* due to unforeseen circumstances.

TIES

- 7.1. In the event of a tie, the lower handicap takes precedence. If it is still a tie, it shall be decided by a count-back, first over the last 9 holes, then last 6 holes, last 3 holes and finally the 18th hole. If the tie is still undecided, it shall be decided by drawing lots.

PRIZES

- 8.1. All participants are entitled to only one prize with the exception of the novelty prize winner. The novelty prizes are for the longest drive (LD), nearest to line (NTL), nearest to pin (NTP) and 'Hole-In-One', if any.
- 8.2. A shot is defined as a 'stroke' by the R&A. Only one shot per player for the designated LD, NTL, NTP and Hole-In-One hole is permitted. No practise shots, muliggans or substitute shot for other players.
- 8.3. The Hole-In-One award, if any, will be divided equally among the players in the event that more than one player achieves the feat.
- 8.4. The overall Gross Champion and the overall Nett Champion will receive PIPOC Golf Challenge Trophy, respectively. There will be a first runners-up for each trophy.
- 8.5. The Medal Winner will be in three categories: 'A' Division; 'B' Division and 'C' Division.
- 8.6. The Committee reserves the right to increase the number of prizes.

ENTRY, CLOSING DATE & FEES

- 9.1. Entries shall be made on the prescribed form and must reach the Committee by 1 October 2023 or any other date as the Committee may so decide. The entry fee for the Championship is RM 480.00 inclusive of green fee, light lunch and dinner.
- 9.2. In the event of no-shows, the entry fee is non-refundable. However, substitution of players will be entertained on a case by case basis 48 hours prior to the event date.
- 9.3. Reciprocal arrangements with any participating clubs will not apply to this tournament. Members of the host venue shall pay the same rate as non-club members.
- 9.4. All cheques are to be made payable to "Malaysian Palm Oil Board (MPOB)".

FLIGHT TEE-OFF LIST

- 10.1. The Committee reserves the right to make alterations to the flight tee-off list, as and when it deemed fit so that the game can start without undue delay.

RULES & DECISIONS

- 11.1. The Committee's decision in all matters pertaining to this tournament shall be final.

DRESS CODE

- 12.1. Staffield Country Resort observes the following Rule of Attire for Golfers and participants are required to comply:

Men: Sports shirt with collar and sleeves. The shirt must be tucked into the trousers/pants (not more than 6 inches above the knee). Jogging shorts/pants with denim materials and flowery beach wear are not permitted.

Ladies: Sports shirt with collar and sleeves. The shirt must be tucked into the trousers/pants (not more than 4 inches above the knee). Jogging shorts/pants with denim materials and flowery beach wear are not permitted.

Head gear (Optional) : Cap/Hat/Visor

Footwear : Proper golf shoes with non-metal spike.

SAFETY

- 13.1. MPOB, the Committee and its agents will not be responsible for any bodily injury or lost of personal belongings of the golfers. All participants shall be personally responsible for damage to the club property and third party liabilities caused through negligence whilst and as a consequence of playing the golf.

OTHERS

- 14.1. The Committee has the right to decide on matters which it deems fit in organising the tournament. For matters not explained in the rules and regulations, the decision by the Committee is final.
