FONT PAIRING EXAMPLE 2: PLAYFAIR DISPLAY + LATO

Sophisticated Heading with Playfair

Body text using Lato creates a classic yet contemporary feel. This pairing is perfect for editorial content, luxury brands, and creative portfolios. The high contrast serif headline with clean sans-serif body creates visual hierarchy.

BOLD HEADING WITH OSWALD

Body text using Merriweather provides excellent readability. This combination works great for news articles, blogs, and content-heavy documents. The condensed headline font with the reader-friendly serif body creates perfect balance.

Font Size & Weight Hierarchy

Heading 1 – 48px Bold

Heading 2 – 36px Semibold

Heading 3 – 28px Semibold

Heading 4 – 22px Medium

Heading 5 – 18px Regular

Body Text – 16px Regular with increased line height for better readability. This is the standard size for paragraphs and main content.

Small Text – 14px Regular for captions and secondary information
