

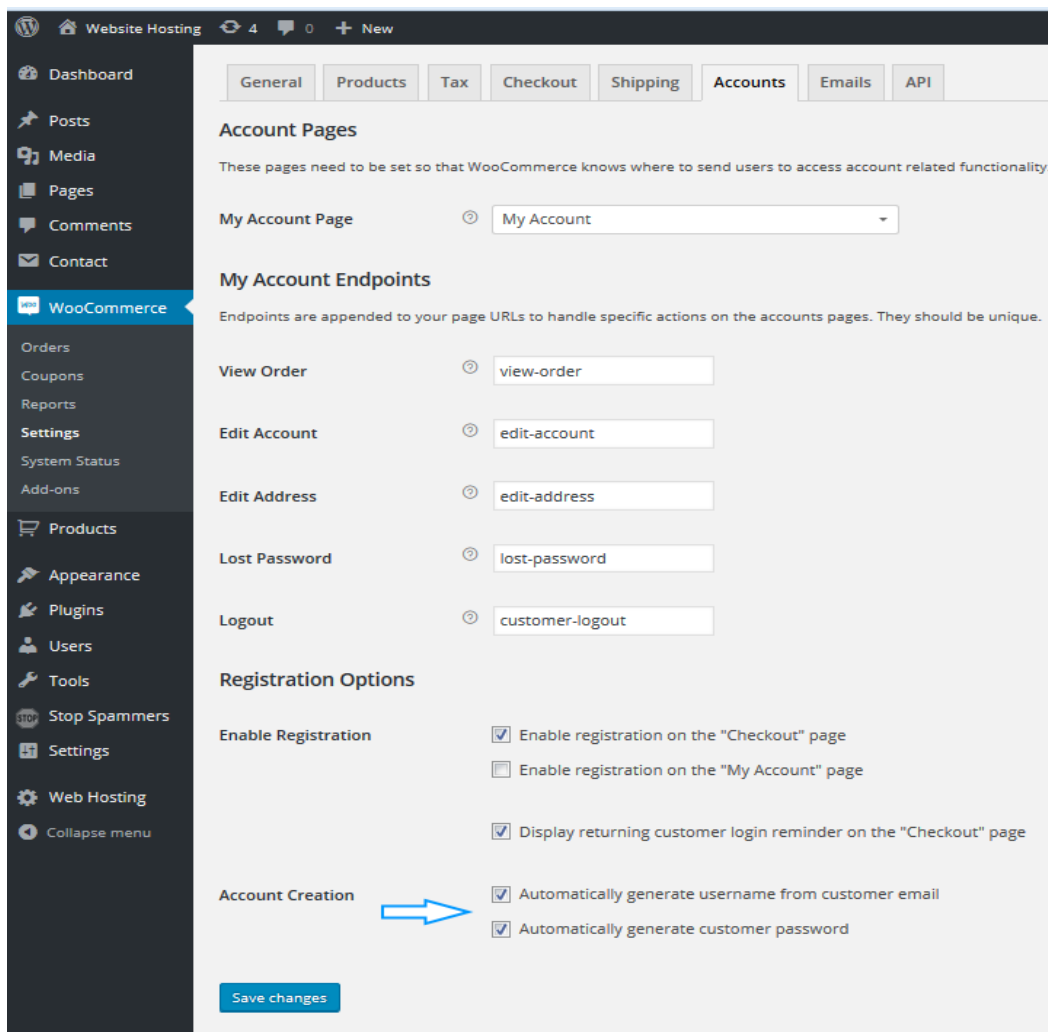
How to configure Web Hosting plugin

Install WooCommerce plugin

In left-hand admin menu go-to **WooCommerce** → **Settings** and click on **Accounts** tab


In **Account Creation** Section if not checked
check **Automatically generate username from customer email**
check **Automatically generate customer password**

save changes.



Click on Checkout tab
In Checkout Section
Uncheck Enable guest checkout

Checkout Process

Coupons

- Enable the use of coupons
Coupons can be applied from the cart and checkout pages.
- Calculate coupon discounts sequentially
When applying multiple coupons, apply the first coupon to the full price of the cart.

Checkout 

- Enable guest checkout
Allows customers to checkout without creating an account.
- Force secure checkout
Force SSL (HTTPS) on the checkout pages (an SSL Certificate is required).

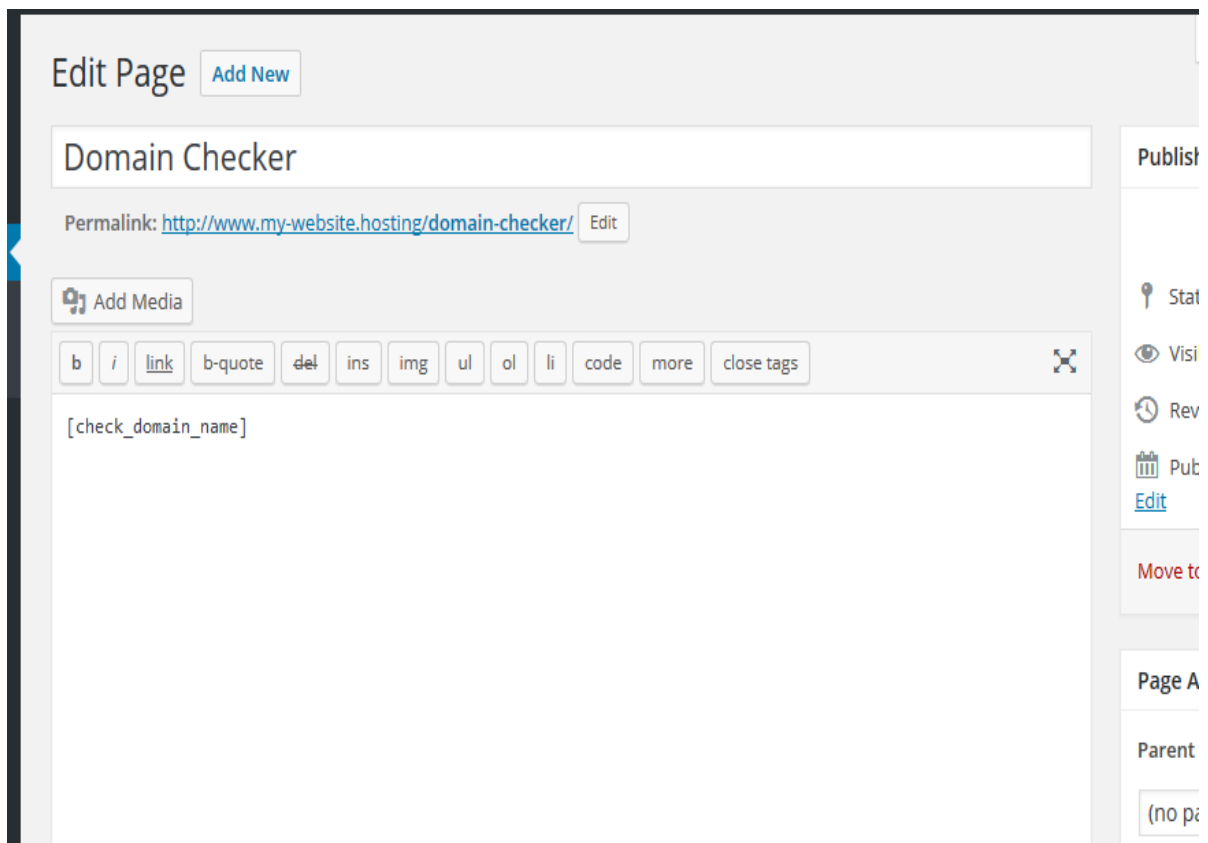

Hosting Packages Page: page URL where your hosting packages are displayed e.g. /web-hosting/


Add-ons: page URL where your Add-ons are displayed e.g. /addons/

Domains

In left-hand admin menu go-to Web Hosting → Domains

enter in the first box (Number of TLD to sell:) the number of TLD's you wish to sell then click save this will create the required number of boxes needed. Enter the TLD's and your selling prices. Click Save Changes again.

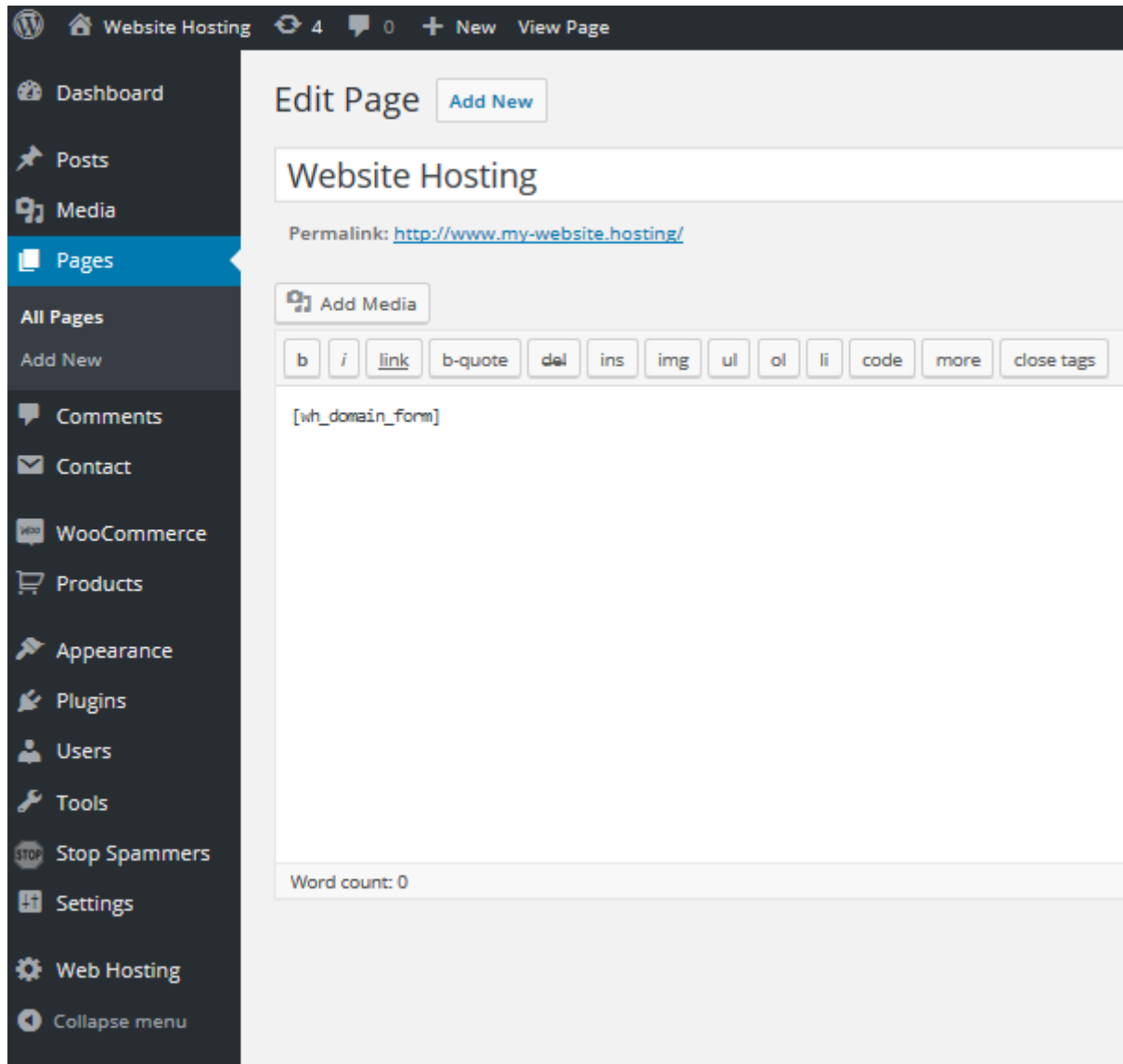

Shortcodes

Use shortcode `[wh_domain_form]` on any page post or in a widget to display search domain name form.



`[wh_transfer_domain_form]` used to create a transfer domain form on any page post or widget.

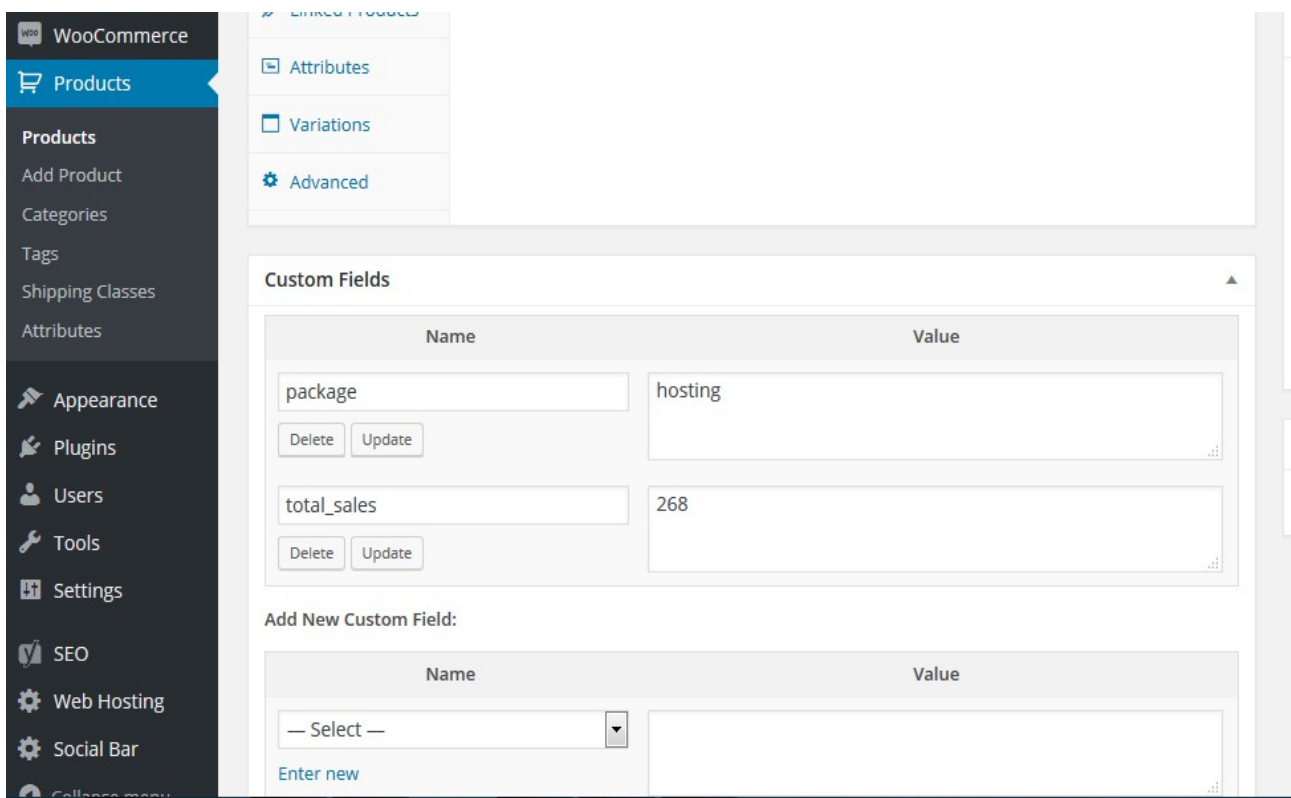
`[wh_wp_logout]` used to add logout link to any page post or widget.

My Account

[wh_extra_fields] Use shortcode on any page to show customer account details it's probably best to put this shortcode in my-account page this shortcode will display domain names, hosting packages, add-ons and allow customers to manage their domains.

Adding Hosting Packages

Just create your product as normal but you will need to add a custom field called package with a value called hosting. This is so the plugin can tell the difference between hosting products and domain products. To view custom fields if its hidden click on Screen Options at the top of the page and check Custom Fields.

When naming hosting products the name must match your package name on WHM for example

package name on WHM = webuk_basic-shared-hosting

your product name = basic-shared-hosting

Invoices

There is a couple of ways to automatically send due invoices.

1 add the shortcode [wh_subscriptions] to a secret page which you can load once a day this will activate the code to check customers orders and look for any orders in which payments are due if any are found a new order will be created. The customer will receive an order and invoice in PDF format. These new orders will be created 7 days before they are due for payment.

2 add this code to your themes header `do_action('wh_subscription');` your website should get at least one page load per day if not then I recommend using option 3.

3 use plugin Advanced Cron Manager and add a new task using `wh_subscriptions` as a hook.

To change the default logo on order emails and invoices place your logo into the `www.yoursite.com/wp-content/plugins/web-hosting/images/` folder and name it `logo.png` image must be 100px X 100px in size.
